

MINUTES OF AN EXTRAORDINARY MEETING OF EDLINGTON TOWN COUNCIL HELD ON TUESDAY 26th APRIL, 2022 AT 3PM IN THE COUNCIL OFFICES, STUBBINS HILL, EDLINGTON.
